Faculty members, student representatives, and anti-ragging committee members actively participated in these activities to promote a safe, inclusive, and disciplined learning environment.

- The importance of maintaining **professional conduct, empathy, and teamwork** in nursing education was highlighted.
- Pamphlets and posters describing **“Zero Tolerance Toward Ragging”** were displayed on notice boards.

- Students developed a clear understanding of the legal, ethical, and emotional aspects of ragging.
- The sessions encouraged open communication between faculty and students.
